

Statement of Commitment

- Specific Commitment to Christian Education: Christian education gives God His rightful place in all aspects of creation. He is
 acknowledged as the Creator of all that exists, the Savior and Lord of those who believe in Him, and the loving and righteous
 Judge of mankind. God's truths as revealed through His work (nature) and His Word (Scripture) are the basis of a Christian

In the school setting, they specifically encourage obedience to school faculty and staff, respect for fellow students, consistent attendance, punctuality, appropriate dress, and diligence to schoolwork.
- 4. Involvement in School Parent Activities: The Wooster Christian School Parent-Teacher Fellowship serves as a liaison between parents and the school. The organization provides many opportunities to support the school educational program inside and outside the classroom. An active interest in school affairs by a parent and/or guardian is invaluable to the school and its students.
